8:00-9:00pm	Special Opportunity: Interactive Virtual Diagnosis Of A Patient In The Developing World (Live with Nigeria)	"Discover how technological innovation is transforming healthcare around the world by viewing a live presentation. Participants will be transported to a hospital in Bauchi State Nigeria, where they will be able to interact with patients in real-time. Using a doctor in Nigeria as an extension of themselves, one pre-trained high school student will use Oculus Rift Goggles to examine and diagnose a patient who cannot afford medical care. This presentation is hosted by Leadership Initiatives in a partnership with Georgetown University. Each summer they host the world's first internship program for high school students in advanced diagnostic training on the four leading causes of death in the developing world: malaria, typhoid fever, nutritional anemia, and acute respiratory infections (ARI). For their final project using Oculus Rift technology students will then diagnose a patient in sub-Saharan Africa with a doctor in real-time and recommend a treatment.
